John 9 Jesus Heals A Blind Man

1. The people of Jesus' day thought that disabilities like blindness were the result of some specific sin. What did Jesus have to say about that? (cf. John 9:3)
2. How was God's glory revealed in this blind man's life?

3. How did Jesus use the “tragedy” of death to display his glory?
4. Although Jesus raised Lazarus from the dead, we assume that Lazarus eventually died again. How does Isaiah 57:1, 2 assure us that this death (and every believer's death) is actually a blessing?
5. According to Luke 13:1-5, how should we react when we hear about tragedy?
6. According to Hebrews 12:7-11 why does God allow hardship?
