Lesson Fourteen: The New Jerusalem

Revelation 21:1-8 *A New Start*

1. Explain: After Judgment Day, heaven won't be in the heavens (if it is now at all).
2. According to Rev. 21:3-8, what two things can we say for certain about a believer's life after Judgment Day? (Fill in the blanks.) We will live with _____ in all of his _____, and we will never experience anything _____ ever again.

3. What exactly is the "new Jerusalem" John saw coming down out of heaven? (cf. Hebrews 12:22, 23; Revelation 20:9; 21:9)
4. What comfort can Christians gain from the following descriptions of the New Jerusalem?
v. 11 *It shone with the glory of God and its brilliance was like that of a very precious jewel* (cf. Rev. 21:23)

vs. 18, 19 *the city of pure gold... The foundations of the city walls were decorated with every kind of precious stone.* (cf. 1 Peter 2:5)

v. 14 *city had twelve foundations... on them were the names of the twelve apostles* (cf. Ephesians 2:20)

v. 12 *had twelve [pearl] gates... on them were written the names of the twelve tribes of Israel* (cf. Rom. 9:8)

vs. 16, 17 *city was 12,000 stadia (1,400 miles) long, wide, and high... city wall... 144 cubits (200 feet) thick*

v. 18 *wall was made of jasper* (cf. Zechariah 2:4, 5)

v. 25 *On no day will its gates ever be shut* (cf. Revelation 21:27)

6. Why should we not be surprised that the Bible “ends” where it “started”?
